Spirit Airlines Initiates Weather Buster Policy for Winter Storm Hercules

In order to offer customers flexibility, Spirit Airlines has activated its Weather Buster protection policy in response to potential flight changes resulting from Winter Storm Hercules.

For customers holding reservations for travel to, from or through affected locations detailed below between Thursday, January 2, 2014 and Friday, January 3, 2014, Spirit Airlines will waive the change fee and difference in fare, provided that customers rebook their travel plans before the date and time of their original reservation, and travel on or before January 10, 2014.

Customers who wish to move their travel beyond January 10, 2013, will not be charged a change fee, however any difference in fare will apply.
