### **Spirit Airlines Initiates Weather Buster Policy**

In order to offer customers flexibility, Spirit Airlines has activated its Weather Buster Protection policy in response to potential flight changes resulting from Winter Storm Nika.

For customers holding reservations for travel to, from or through affected locations on Wednesday, February 5, 2014, Spirit Airlines will waive the change fee and difference in fare, provided that customers rebook their travel plans before the date and time of their original reservation, and travel on or before Thursday, February 13, 2014.

Customers who wish to move their travel beyond February 13, 2014, will not be charged a change fee; however any difference in fare will apply.
